PLAN YOUR OWN ALFRED STATE EXPERIENCE!

Accepted students interested in experiencing Alfred State are invited to participate in our overnight visit program.

Program includes:

- Information sessions
- Academic department tour
- Campus activities
- Overnight accommodations in one of our residence halls with a current student

Information sessions include:

- General information session
- Academic overview
- Campus Life
- Admissions

Meals provided include:

- Dinner upon arrival
- Breakfast
- Lunch prior to departure

A suggested list of items to bring will be provided in the information packet sent prior to your visit.

NOTE: Participants are responsible for their own transportation to and from Alfred State, with the exception of the April 11 NYC bus trip.

Shortline Bus service is available into the village of Alfred. The bus stop is within a block of campus. You must buy your round trip ticket before coming to Alfred.

The program begins at 4:30 p.m. and will conclude at 1 p.m. the following day.

Detailed information regarding the program schedule for your specific dates will be included with your information packet.

What is Experience Alfred State?

A program designed to offer high school seniors, who have been accepted, the opportunity to visit and witness first-hand the Alfred State community.

What is involved?

An overnight stay, a campus tour, an academic department tour, several information sessions, campus dining, meeting current and future Alfred State students, exposure to the life lived by our students here on campus, as well as an opportunity to have all of your questions answered.

Where do I sleep?

Spend the night in residential housing with a current Alfred State student. Student hosts are proven campus leaders who are involved in a variety of campus clubs and organizations.

To reserve your space for one of the overnight visits, you must send in your completed registration form and a \$20 reservation fee (check or money order payable to Alfred State).

Will I get to visit my specific academic department?

Yes, all students attending this program will meet with a representative from the program they have been accepted to and will have the opportunity to ask questions specific to their major.

Do I need spending money?

Meals are provided and any activity organized for Experience Alfred State is at no additional cost to you beyond your initial \$20 registration fee. Bring money if you wish to make a purchase at the campus store.

Parents: An optional parent session, including information about financial aid, student life, learning services, and more will be held on the second day of each program from 9:30 a.m. - 12 noon. With the exception of the April 11, NYC visit.

Students from the New York City area who have been accepted for the fall 2017 semester are invited to experience Alfred State on April 11-12. A chartered bus will depart from the Public Library in Manhattan (5th Ave between 41st & 42nd) at 8 a.m. on Sunday, April 11, and return to the same location on Monday, April 12, at approximately 10 p.m. The program is designed to give high school seniors, who have been accepted, the opportunity to visit and witness first-hand the Alfred State community. Unfortunately, due to space constraints on the bus, parents are discouraged from attending and there will be no parent session on this date.

Will there be anyone from Alfred State on the bus?

Ann Baldwin, who recruits in the NYC area, will be on the bus going both directions.
